The people of Lavender Hill Audio Walk

Below is a visual story to give you more information about the **The people of Lavender Hill** audio walk.

Here are some other things to consider, before you look through the pictures below:

- All of the crossings included in the walk have **drop curbs**.
- Lavender Hill is a relatively **busy road**, so whenever you are on the walk, there is likely to be noise from traffic.
- The audio walk is accessible via smartphones, but if you don't have one, you can pick up an MP3 from **Battersea Art Centre's Welcome Desk**.
- The walking route is roughly **30-35 minutes**, but the audio walk is around **60 minutes**. There is seating along the route.
- This is an **outside walk** along Lavender Hill and there is no expectation or need to enter any of the businesses on this audio walk unless you would like to. Some of the business have steps, those with step-free access are marked on your route map.
- If you are borrowing an MP3 player you will be required to leave an ID or driving licence as a deposit when collecting it from BAC Welcome Desk. Please also note that we have a limited number of MP3 players available, and they will be prioritised for people who do not have access to smartphones.




Outside Battersea Arts Centre

This is the outside of Battersea Arts Centre, the beginning of this audio walk.

You can enter to begin the audio walk.

There is step free access.



Inside Battersea Arts Centre

This is the BAC welcome desk.

You can pick up a route map here and an MP3 player, if you don't have access to a smart phone.

BAC is the **first stop** on the audio walk



Outside Battersea Arts Centre

You will head down Lavender Hill in this direction.

This crossing has a dropped curb.



Church

Church of the Ascension, Lavender Hill is the **second stop** on the audio walk.



Roadworks

There are some road works at the crossing by the church which makes the crossing a little narrower.

It also means there are occasional loud noises from building works.



A place to listen

If you would rather listen off the pavement, there is some space to the left.



A good place to cross

Continue down Lavender Hill and then cross at this crossing.

There is a dropped curb, but there are no traffic lights. There is an island in the middle of the road.

Carry on to your right, up the hill.



HD CUTZ

HD Cuts is the **third spot** on the audio walk.


There is **seating outside** that is protected by an outside cover.



Crossings

There are a couple of road crossings like this one before you reach the fourth spot on the walk.

These small crossings continue along this stretch of pavement.




Lavender Hill DIY

Lavender Hill DIY is the **fourth stop** on the audio walk and the outside looks like this.



Labour Party Office

Labour Party Office is **stop number five.**



A good place to cross


This section of the walk has fake grass over part of the pavement, which will have a different texture and might make the surface uneven.

Carry on to your right, up the hill.



Harley's Food Hall

This is Harley's Food Hall and it is **stop number six**



Crossing Island

After Harley's Food Hall, there is a large road crossing.

This crossing has traffic lights and a crossing island.




Lily's Laundrette

Lily's Laundrette and Alterations is your **seventh stop** of the walk.

There is a pothole outside of the stop, causing uneven ground.

Battersea Library

This is the outside of Battersea Library, and it is your eighth stop.

There is a bench outside.




Step free Access

There is step free access to the library to the left.

Shortly after the library, there is another seating option.



Continue

Continue down Lavender Hill.



Crossing

Cross at this **level crossing** and then continue up hill to the right.



Narrow Pavement

There are signs on this side of the road that make the pavement a bit narrower.




Ladbrokes

Ladbrokes is stop number nine.



HSBC

HSBC is stop number ten.



Crossing

This crossing has a drop curb and an island, but no traffic lights.




Seating

There is **seating** here, outside the Post Office.



Song Hong

Song Hong, a Vietnamese Restaurant, is the **eleventh stop** on the audio walk.



Crossing

This is the final large road crossing before the end of the walk.



Last Stop

Here you are approaching the final point of the walk, **Battersea Arts Centre**.
